UPCOMING FORUMS AT OCTOBER FLY-IN

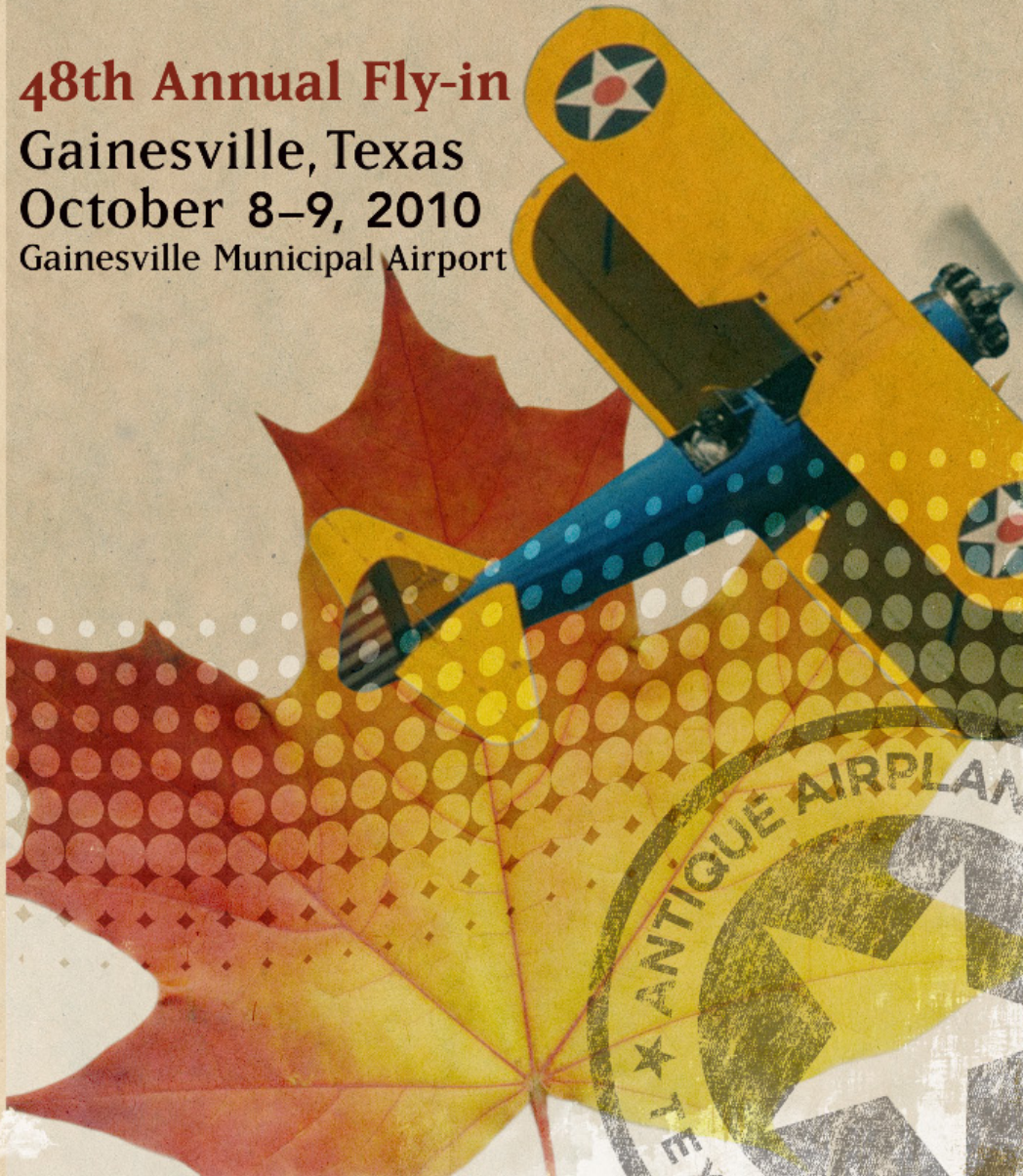
