

1941 CULVER CADET

I am trying to find the elevator trim system complete with the trim tab for a 1941 Culver Cadet. Drawings or good photos would also be helpful.

I somehow got involved probably because I bought Lloyd Washburn's last project, a Culver Dart. The Cadet involved came out of Texas maybe 25 years ago (N34864). The new owner took it home to Florida, enjoyed it for a few years and then began a long restoration. He moved back to Ohio recently. He listed it for sale and a buyer called me to look it over for him. I found a beautiful little airplane with two major problems. During the restoration the owner modified the landing gear and the trim system so it no longer complies with the Type Certificate. I have a good relationship with the local FSDO and found the landing gear mod

can be approved by 337 locally but control system mods will have to go to FAA engineering. The out come is uncertain and will certainly take a long time. The best solution is to find an original trim system.

Please pass this on to anyone you know who may be able to help. I would hate to see this little plane end up in a museum or worse a trash heap. I am trying to help to owner and am working gratis. I would love to see the Cadet flying again.
