Meet me speaker was Ed Parrott, who gave a presentation.

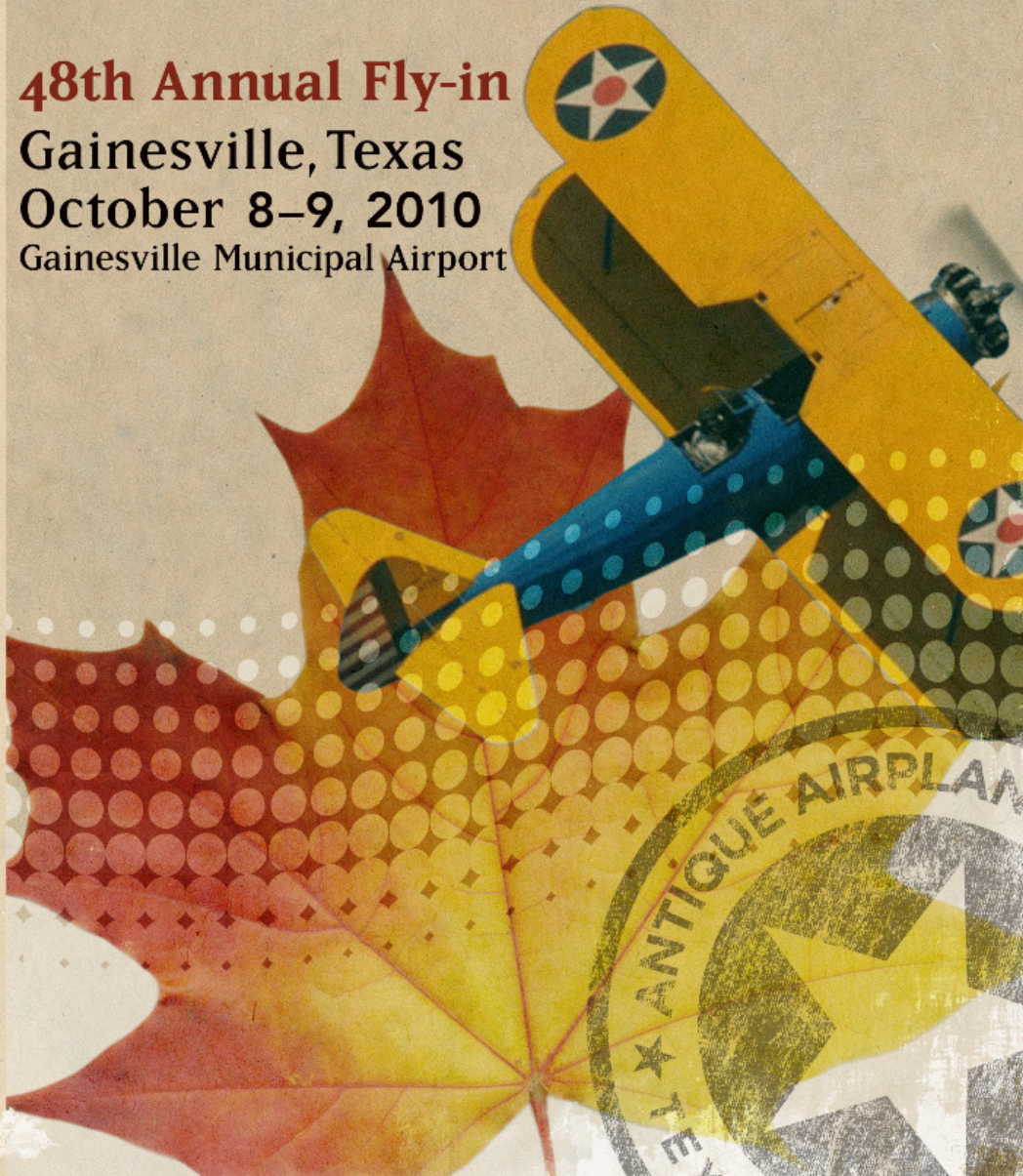
Next Meeting: The next meeting is at Cedar Mills, Texas on July 17, 2010.
