You may park in grass in front of Jim Austin's hangar. Terry's hangar is 2 hangars to the East of Austin's.

For Drivers: From IH 35W take Hwy 1171 exit and go East on 1171 to Cleveland-Gibbs Road. Turn South (right) on Cleveland-Gibbs Rd. As you come into the Airport on Cleveland-Gibbs Rd. take a right at the stop sign and go north to the dead end. Turn left and his hangar is the fourth one on the left.

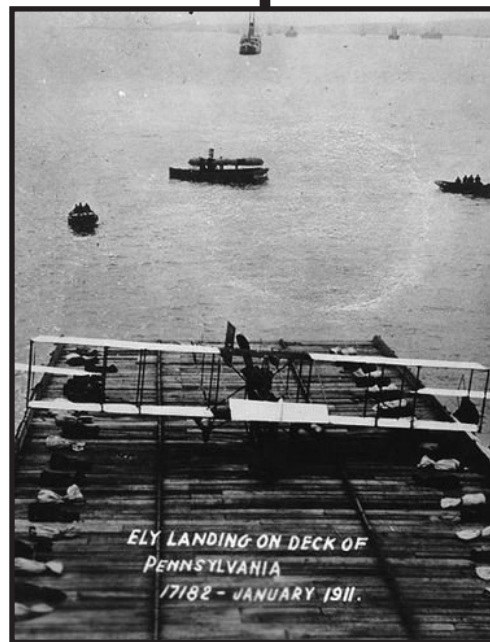

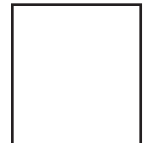
