Presidents Corner...





Bert Mahon Chili Cook-Off

As you know, our November meeting holds our annual Bert Mahon Chili Cook-Off, in honor of former TX AAA Chapter member Bert Mahon.

"Bert Mahon was born in Caney, Kansas on March of 1937 and married his wife Mary in 1967. Bert learned to fly in about 1970 and his instructor was well known antiquer, Gene Chase. Gene was a fellow coworker at Standard Oil in Tulsa.

The Mahon family hangar would house many a vintage airplane over the years. A Stinson HW75, Fairchild 24, a Spartan C-2-60, Cessna 195, Cessna 180, Globe Swift along with Mary's Aeronca Chief. They lived at Justin Time airport in Justin, Texas for many years before building a hangar to base their airplanes at the Denton airport.

Bert served in the United States Marine Corps, worked for Standard Oil, the Western Company and Ensearch Exploration before owning his own mortgage business in Denton, Texas for several years. He also taught as a Ground School Instructor for American Airlines. A private pilot for more than forty years, Bert was Lifetime Member #67 of the Antique Airplane Association. The Mahon's were long time members and hosts of many Texas AAA Chapter meetings until Bert's passing in 2009.

Mary Mahon retired from American Airlines after 25 years and now lives in Deer Park, Washington. She lives close to son Kelly Mahon, wife Raina and grandchildren Curtis and Ryan. Several times a year she travels to visit daughter, Tracey Elliot, husband Ken and grandchildren Will and Mary who have just moved to Parsons, Kansas."
