The last one was a couple of weeks ago and featured two new aircraft making their public debuts, an Albatros D.II (finished in Oswald Boelcke's markings) and TVAL's third Sopwith Snipe (finished as F2367 "1-2", B flight 70 Sqn, Bickendorf, March-April 1919, which is one of markings provided by Wingnut Wings in their 'late' version of the Snipe). The weather was very kind on the day and most of the (extensive) collection flew - fantastic experience for a WWI aviation enthusiast, the buzz lasted for days. However, some chapters have decided not to split the cost of getting insurance, as a result each chapter of the National AAA must now procure their own insurance policy which must contain a rider to cover the National AAA as well as the chapter.

I have reached out to Lisa at Butler Brown Insurance to give us a quote on our own insurance. Our previous policy covered our chapter and National for around \$1000, which included all year chapter activities. I'm sure this new policy will be around the same cost, but will wait to get the quote. After I have this info we will discuss further options.
